Second week, check!

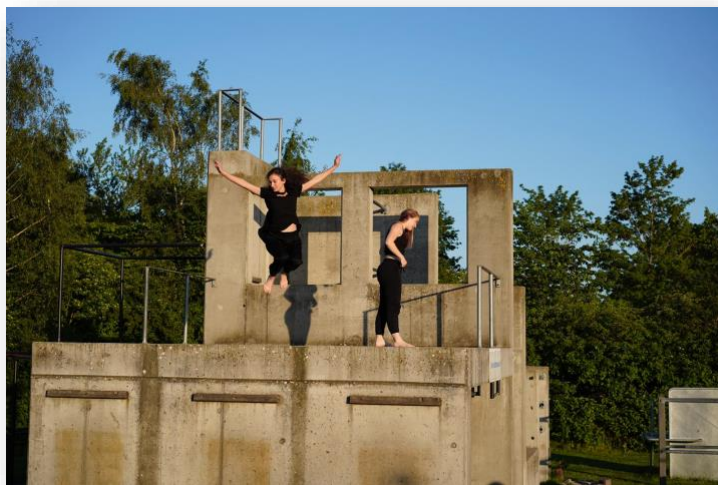
